To free him you need to work out a secret code. Complete the 6 challenges below.

Make sure you ask an adult for help with the experiments.

1 Which letter is missing from the logo at the top of the page?

2 Which country is famous for having ancient pyramids?

3 Put an orange in a jug of water. Take it out again and peel it making sure to remove the stem at the top and place it back in the jug. Does the orange float or sink?



4 **Fit your whole body through an A4 piece of paper.**

Think it's impossible, here are some tips. You will need a pair of scissors.

Step 1 – Fold the piece of paper in half widthways.

Step 2 - ___ into the folded side, about 1 cm from the left hand edge, and start to ___ straight towards the far side of the paper. Stop about 1 cm before the opposite edge, so you don't ___ all the way across the paper.

Step 3 - Turn the paper around so the fold is away from you. ___ in around 1 cm from the last ___ and stop about 1 cm before you get to the folded side.

Step 4 – Repeat all the way along the paper, alternating from the folded side to the open side.

Step 5 – Look along the folded side of the paper. You should have a series of loops of paper. ___ along the fold of each of the loops EXCEPT the first loop and the last loop. Leave these intact.

Clinton was captured and in a horrible situation that he had no chance of escaping from by himself. To be rescued and set free, he needed your help. The Bible speaks a lot about people being rescued and set free. There is even a special name for this; salvation. Salvation simply means to be saved or rescued and set free. King David the man who wrote many of the Psalms we have looked at recently knew he needed rescuing and setting free. In one of them he wrote: "Truly my soul finds rest in God; my salvation comes from him. Truly he is my rock and my salvation; he is my fortress, I will never be shaken."

Christians believe that, like King David, we all need rescuing and setting free. Clinton was in prison though and we aren't, so what do we need rescuing from?

Have you ever noticed how easy it is to do the things we know we shouldn't do? (The Bible calls these things 'sin') It's like being in a prison and we can't escape. Christians believe we need someone to rescue us, to set us free, and that person is Jesus! The Bible tells us that when Jesus died on the cross and came back to life, he defeated the power of sin to spoil our lives. It's as if Jesus has handed us the key so we could escape from the prison of 'sin' and be free to live as God's friend. Like Clinton to escape we need to use the key! We do that by saying sorry to God and asking him to be our Saviour or 'rescuer'.
